Factories and Shops Acts.

## DETERMINATION OF THE DAIRY PRODUCE AND COOKED MEAT BOARD.

NOTE.—This Determination on the 7th June, 1920, applied to the Metropolitan District as defined in the Factories and Shops Acts; the cities of Ballarat, Bendigo, Geelong, and Warrnambool; the towns of Ballarat East and Sandringham; and the boroughs of Eaglehawk, Geelong West, Newtown and Chilwell, and Sebastopol.

IN accordance with the provisions of the Factories and Shops Acts the Wages Board appointed to "determine the lowest prices or rates which may be paid to any persons employed in the trade of a seller of Dairy Produce or Cooked Meat," has made the following Determination, namely:—

- (1) That on the 7th June, 1920, the previous Determination of this Board shall be revoked and replaced by this Determination.

One apprentice to every three or fraction of three male workers receiving not less than 40s. per week of 48 hours.							
Improvers							
One improver to first three or fraction of three, two to four; and thereafter one to every additional three female workers receiving not less than 40s. per week of 48 hours.							
Apprentices							
One apprentice to every three or fraction of three male workers receiving not less than 65s. per week of 48 hours.							
Improvers							
One improver to first two or fraction of two, two to three; and thereafter one improver to every additional two male workers not under the age of 23 years.
