Factories and Shops Acts.

DETERMINATION OF THE PERAMBULATOR BOARD.

NOTE.—This Determination on the 19th March, 1920, applied to the following parts of Victoria, viz.:—The Metropolitan District as defined in the Factories and Shops Acts; the cities of Ballarat, Bendigo, Geelong, and Warrnambool; the towns of Ballarat East and Sandringham; and the boroughs of Eaglehawk, Geelong West, Newtown and Chilwell, and Sebastopol.

IN accordance with the provisions of the Factories and Shops Acts, the Wages Board appointed to "determine the lowest prices or rates which may be paid to any persons employed in the process, trade, or business of a maker of perambulators", has made the following Determination, namely:—

(1) That on the 19th March, 1920, the last previous Determination of this Board shall be revoked and replaced by this Determination.

(4) TIME OF BEGINNING AND ENDING WORK.

Time of Beginning. Time of Ending.
7.45 a.m. 12.30 p.m. on the day on which the half-holiday is usually observed.
7.45 a.m. 5.30 p.m. on the other working days of the week.

(5) OVERTIME.

Within the hours fixed in Clause (4) in excess of 48 hours in any week Time and a quarter.
Outside the hours fixed in Clause (4)—

	On Saturday (or the day on which the half-holiday is usually observed).	On other days.
Between midnight and 7.45 a.m.	Double time	Double time
Between 12.30 p.m. and 5 p.m.	Time and a quarter

Provided that no apprentice or improver shall be employed working overtime at less than 6d. per hour.

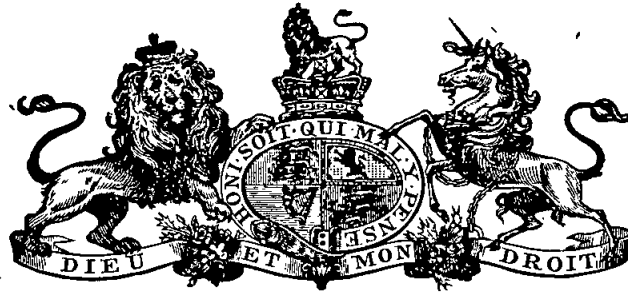
(5) SPECIAL RATES.—Double time shall be the rate for all work done on New Year's Day, 26th January (Foundation Day), Good Friday, Easter Monday, 21st April (Eight Hours Day), Christmas Day, and Boxing Day; but if any other day be by Act of Parliament or Proclamation substituted for any of the above-named holidays, the special rate shall only be payable for work done on the day so substituted.
