Factories and Shops Acts.

DETERMINATION OF THE PLUMBERS BOARD.

Note .- This Determination on the 26th September, 1921, applied to the whole of the State of Victoria.

IN accordance with the provisions of the Factories and Shops Acts, the Wages Board appointed to determine the lowest prices or rates which may be paid to any person or persons or classes of persons—

- (a) Employed either inside or outside a factory or work room in the process, trade, or business of a plumber or gasfitter;
- (b) Wherescever employed in any plumbing work (including electrical or gas fittings) in connexion with the erection or repairing of buildings,

has made the following Determination, namely:-

- (1) That on the 26th September, 1921, the last previous Determination shall be revoked and replaced by this Determination.
