Factories and Shops Acts.

DETERMINATION OF THE CHAR WORKERS BOARD.

Note.—This Determination on the 21st September, 1923, applied to the following parts of Victoria, namely:—The Metropolitan District as defined in the Factories and Shops Acts; the cities of Ballarat, Bendigo, Geelong, Sandringham, and Warrnambool; the town of Geelong West; and the boroughs of Eaglehawk, Newtown and Chilwell, and Sebastopol.

IN accordance with the provisions of the Factories and Shops Acts, the Wages Board appointed "to determine the lowest prices or rates which may be paid to any persons (other than persons subject to the jurisdiction of the Hotel Employees Board) employed at charing work in or about any building in which any process, trade, business, or occupation is carried on," has made the following Determination,
