Factories and Shops Acts.

DETERMINATION OF THE FARRIERS BOARD.

NOTE.—This Determination on the 3rd January, 1924, applied to the following parts of Victoria, namely:—The Metropolitan District as defined in the Factories and Shops Acts; the cities of Ballarat, Bendigo, Geelong, Sandringham, and Warrnambool; the town of Geelong West; and the boroughs of Eaglehawk, Newtown and Chilwell, and Sebastopol.

IN accordance with the provisions of the Factories and Shops Acts, the Wages Board appointed to "determine the lowest prices or rates which may be paid to any person or persons, or classes of persons, employed in the process, trade, or business of a farrier," has made the following Determination, namely:—

(1) That on the 3rd January, 1924, the last previous Determination of this Board shall be revoked and replaced by this Determination.
