Factories and Shops Acts.

DETERMINATION OF THE FARRIERS BOARD.

Note.—This Determination on the 3rd January, 1924, applied to the following parts of Victoria, namely:—The Metropolitan District as defined in the Factories and Shops Acts; the cities of Ballarat, Bendigo, Geolong, Sandringham, and Warrnambool; the town of Geolong West; and the boroughs of Eaglehawk, Newtown and Chilwell, and Sebastopol.

In accordance with the provisions of the Factories and Shops Acts, the Wages Board appointed to "determine the lowest prices or rates which may be paid to any person or persons, or classes of persons, employed in the process, trade, or business of a farrier," has

the times of beginning and ending work :— (a) On Saturdays-Between 8.30 a.m. and 9.30 a.m. Double time. Later than 9.30 a.m. or earlier than 6.30 a.m. ... Treble time. (b) On Mondays, Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Thursdays-Treble time. (c) On Fridays-Between 4.30 p.m. and 5.30 p.m. Later than 5.30 p.m. or earlier than 6.30 a.m. Double time.

B. Within the hours fixed as the times of beginning and ending work in excess of 44 hours .. Double time.

(5) SPECIAL RATES.—Treble time shall be the special rate for all work done on Sunday, 26th January (Foundation Day), Good Friday, Easter Monday, 21st April (Eight Hours Day), 3rd June (King's Birthday), Christmas Day, Boxing Day, and New Year's Day, but if any other day be by Act of Parliament or Proclamation substituted for any of the above-named holidays, the special rate shall only be payable for work done on the day so substituted.

(6) DAY AND LATEST HOURS FOR PAYMENT OF WAGES.—The day and latest hour when payment of wages is to be made shall be Friday at 4.30 p.m.

(7) TIME WAGES.—Any person employed on time wages for less than the number of hours fixed for an ordinary week's work shall for each hour worked up to 22 hours be paid at the ordinary wages rate with an addition of forty-two per centum.
