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Factories and Shops Acts.

DETERMINATION OF THE SHOPS BOARD No. 21 (BOOKSELLERS AND NEWS AGENTS).

NOTE.—This Determination on the 30th April, 1923, applied to the following parts of Victoria, viz.—The Metropolitan District as defined in the Factories and Shops Acts; the cities of Ballarat, Bendigo, Geelong, Sandringham, and Warrnambool; the town of Geelong West; and the boroughs of Eaglehawk, Newtown and Chilwell, and Sebastopol.

In accordance with the provisions of the Factories and Shops Acts, the Wages Board appointed to “determine the lowest prices or rates which may be paid to any persons employed in booksellers and news agents’ shops” has made the following Determination, namely:—

NOTE.—On the 7th March, 1923, the powers of the Board were extended to enable it to fix rates for persons employed in the trade of a wholesale bookseller and news agent.

(1) That on the 30th April, 1923, the previous Determination of this Board shall be revoked and replaced by this Determination.

(3) Any person employed on time wages for less than the number of hours fixed for an ordinary week's work shall for each hour worked up to 24 hours be paid at the ordinary wages rate with an addition of thirty-three and one-third per centum.

(4) OVERTIME.—Any employee who in any week works for any time in excess of 48 hours shall be paid for such extra time at the rate of time and a half.
