Factories and Shops Acts.

DETERMINATION OF THE ENGRAVERS BOARD.

NOTE.—(1) This Determination on the 2nd June, 1923, applied to the following parts of Victoria, namely:—The Metropolitan District as defined in the Factories and Shops Acts; the cities of Ballarat, Bendigo, Geelong, Sandringham, and Warrnambool; the town of Geelong West; and the boroughs of Eaglehawk, Newtown, and Chilwell, and Sebastopol.

(2) The Engravers Board when first constituted had power to fix rates for any person or persons, or classes of persons, employed in the process, trade, or business of a process engraver. This power was taken away by Order in Council dated 26th August, 1913.

(3) On the 2nd October, 1917, the powers of the Engravers Board were extended to enable it to fix the lowest prices or rates which may be paid to any persons employed in the process, trade, business, or occupation of making (but not enamelling) metal badges.

IN accordance with the provisions of the Factories and Shops Acts, the Wages Board appointed to "determine the lowest prices or rates which may be paid to any person or persons or classes of persons employed in the process, trade, or business of an engraver or die-sinker," has made the following Determination, namely:—

(1) That on the 2nd day of June, 1923, the last previous Determination of this Board shall be revoked and replaced by this Determination.

One improver to every four workers receiving not less than 107s. 6d. per week.

(4) OVERTIME—

(a) Outside the hours fixed in Clause 3 8d. per hour in addition to the ordinary rate.

(b) Within the hours fixed in Clause 3 in excess of 46½ hours in any week

(5) TIME WAGES.—Any person employed on time wages for less than the number of hours fixed for an ordinary week's work shall, for each hour worked up to 23½ hours, be paid at the ordinary wages rate with an addition of thirty-three and a third per centum.

(6) SPECIAL RATES.—Double time shall be the rate for all work done on Sunday, New Year's Day, Foundation Day (26th January), Good Friday, Easter Monday, Eight Hours Day (21st April), Christmas Day, or Boxing Day; but if any other day be by Act of Parliament substituted for any of the above-named holidays, the special rate shall only be payable for work done on the day so substituted.

Factories and Shops Acts.

DETERMINATION OF THE OPTICIANS BOARD.

NOTE.—This Determination on the 8th June, 1923, applied to the Metropolitan District as defined in the Factories and Shops Acts ; the cities of Ballarat, Bendigo, Geelong, Sandringham, and Warrnambool ; the town of Geelong West ; the boroughs of Eaglehawk, Newtown and Chilwell, and Sebastopol.

IN accordance with the provisions of the Factories and Shops Acts, the Wages Board appointed to "determine the lowest prices or rates which may be paid to any persons employed in manufacturing or mounting optical lenses or their frames," has made the following Determination, namely:—

- (1) That on the 8th June, 1923, the previous Determination of this Board shall be revoked and replaced by this Determination.

(4) OVERTIME.

That the following rate shall be paid for all work done :—

- (a) Outside the hours fixed in Clause (3) ... Time and a half.
- (b) Within the hours fixed in Clause (3) in excess of 45½ hours in any week } Time and a half.

(5) TIME RATE.—Any person employed on time wages for less than the number of hours fixed for an ordinary week's work shall for each hour worked up to 22½ hours be paid at the ordinary wages rate with an addition of thirty-three per centum.

(6) SPECIAL RATES.—That double time shall be the special rate for all work done on Sunday, 26th January (Foundation Day), Good Friday, Easter Saturday, Easter Monday, 21st April (Eight Hours Day), King's Birthday, Christmas Day, Boxing Day, New Year's Day ; but, if any other day be by Act of Parliament or Proclamation substituted for any of the above-named holidays, the special rate shall only be payable for work done on the day so substituted.
