EXEMPTION OF A CERTAIN FACTORY IN THE BOROUGH OF EAGLEHAWK FROM THE DETER- MINATION OF THE WOOLLEN TRADE BOARD.

UNDER the powers in that behalf conferred by the Fac-
tories and Shops Acts, His Excellency the Lieutenant-
Governor of the State of Victoria, by and with the advice
of the Executive Council thereof, being of opinion that the
operations of the factory to be affected constitute a new in-
dustry, and that it is expedient so to do, doth hereby order
that the employers and employees in or in connexion with the
factory of the Alexandra Spinning and Knitting Mills Limited,
situate at High-street within the municipal district of the
borough of Eaglehawk, be exempted from the operation of all
of the provisions of the Determination of the Woollen Trade
Board for a period of six months from the date hereof.

REGULATION OF HAIRDRESSERS' SHOPS AND TOBAC- CONISTS' SHOPS WITHIN THE SHIRE OF GOUL- BURN.

UNDER the powers in that behalf conferred by the Factories
and Shops Acts, His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor of
the State of Victoria, by and with the advice of the Executive
Council thereof, upon a petition certified by the municipal
clerk of the municipal district of the shire of Goulburn, as
signed by a majority of all the hairdressers and of all the
tobacconists to be affected, doth hereby make the following
Regulation, that is to say:—

It shall be lawful for hairdressers' shops and tobacconists'
shops within the municipal district of the shire of Goulburn
to be kept open on the evenings of Monday, Tuesday, and
Thursday in each week until the hour of Eight o'clock.

And the Honorable Sir A. J. Peacock, His Majesty's Min-
ister of Labour for the State of Victoria, shall give the
necessary directions herein accordingly.
