Factories and Shops Acts.

## DETERMINATION OF THE CIGAR TRADE BOARD.

Note.—This Determination on the 9th January, 1926, applied to the following parts of Victoria, namely:—The Metropolitan District as defined in the Factories and Shops Acts; the cities of Ballarat, Bendigo, Geelong, Sandringham, and Warrnambool; the towns of Geelong West and Newtown and Chilwell and the boroughs of Eaglehawk, and Sebastopol.

Naccordance with the provisions of the Factories and Shops Acts, the Special Board appointed to "determine the lowest prices or rates which may be paid to any persons or classes of persons employed in the process, trade, or business of Cigar Making," has made the following Determination, viz.:—

(1) That on the 9th January, 1926, the last and all previous determinations of this Board shall be revoked and replaced by this Determination.
