BRIDGE OVER THE YARRA RIVER IN LINE WITH
BRIDGE-ROAD BETWEEN THE MUNICIPALITIES OF
RICHMOND AND HAWTHORN.

ORDER UNDER SECTION 494 OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT ACT
1915 FOR RE-OPENING.

At the Executive Council Chamber, Melbourne, the

WHEREAS the Municipal Council of the Mayor, Councilors, and Citizens of the City of Richmond, on the certificate of the Surveyor of the said city, alleges that the Hawthorn Bridge over the Yarra River in line with Bridge-road connecting the Municipality of the City of Richmond with the Municipality of the City of Hawthorn is unsafe for public traffic, and has caused the same to be closed by erecting a fence or obstruction at the Richmond side of the same to traffic thereon: And whereas the Governor in Council under the powers conferred by section 494 of the *Local Government Act* 1915 has deemed it proper that such bridge be re-opened for public traffic. His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria, by and with the advice of the Executive Council thereof, under the powers referred to by the said section and under all other powers him enabling in that behalf, by this present Order doth hereby direct that the said bridge be re-opened by the said Municipal Council of the Mayor, Councilors, and Citizens of the City of Richmond for public traffic forthwith.

And the Honorable George Louis Goudie, His Majesty's Commissioner for Public Works for the State of Victoria, shall give the necessary directions herein accordingly.
