## PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Honorable Sir William Hill Irvine, Doctor of Laws, Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of St. Michael and St. George; Lieutenant-Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c., &c.

**W**HEREAS The Parliament of Victoria stands prorogued until Tuesday, the twenty-fifth day of May, 1926:  
Now I, the Lieutenant-Governor of the State of Victoria in the Commonwealth of Australia, do by this my Proclamation further prorogue the said Parliament of Victoria until Tuesday, the twenty-second day of June, 1926.

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the State of Victoria aforesaid, at Melbourne, this twenty-fourth day of May, in the year of our Lord One thousand nine hundred and twenty-six, and in the seventeenth year of the reign of His Majesty King George V.
