Factories and Shops Acts.

DETERMINATION OF THE PASTRYCOOKS BOARD.

Note.—This Determination on the 19th July, 1927, applied to the following parts of Victoria, namely:—The Metropolitan District as defined in the factories and Shope Acts; the cities of Ballarat, Bendigo, Geelong, Sundringham, and Warrnambool; the towns of Geelong West and Newtown and Chilwell; and the boroughs of Eaglehawk and Sebastopol.

IN accordance with the provisions of the Factories and Shops Acts, the Wages Board appointed to "determine the lowest prices or rates which may be paid to any person or persons or classes of persons employed in the process, trade, or business of a pastrycook," has made the following Determination, namely:—

(1) That on the 19th July, 1927, the previous Determination of this Board shall be revoked and replaced by this Determination.
