PRESCRIBING ROUTES IN RESPECT OF WHICH LICENCES FOR STAGE MOTOR OMNIBUSES MAY BE GRANTED. ROUTES IN RESPECT OF WHICH

IS Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor, as Deputy for His Excellency the Governor, of the State of Victoria, by and with the advice of the Executive Council thereof, in pursuance of the powers conferred by section 21 of the Motor Omnibus (Urban and Country) Act 1927 (No. 3570), doit by this Order prescribe the routes in respect of which licences for stage motor omnibuses may be granted, as set forth in detail in the schedule hereunder:—

SCHEDULE OF ROUTES IN RESPECT OF WHICH LICENCES FOR STAGE MOTOR OMNIBUSES MAY BE GRANTED.

Route No., Description of Route.

- 1. Basin to Bayswater.—Commencing at the locality known as "The Basin," at or near allotment 72, Parish of Scoresby; thence via Summerville Park to the north-western angle of allotment 65 of the said parish; thence generally westerly to Bayswater Railway Station.
- 2. Geelong to Lorne.—Commencing at the City of Geelong; thence generally south-westerly via the Prince's Highway and Anglesea main road (declared under the provisions of the Country Roads Acts) to the Township of Anglosea; thence further south-westerly via the road commonly known as the Great Ocean-road to the Township of Lorne.
- 3. Melbourne to Warrandyte.—Commencing at the City of Melbourne; thence generally easterly and north-easterly via Bridge-road. Richmond; Church-street. Hawthorn; High-street.

Kew: and the Doncaster-road to the Township of Doncaster; thence generally north-easterly via Doncaster and Heidelberg-Warrandyte roads (declared main roads under the provisions of the Country Roads Acts) to the Township of Warrandyte.

And the Honorable John Percy Jones, His Majesty's Commissioner of Public Works for the State of Victoria, shall give the necessary directions herein accordingly.
