No person shall, without the consent of the Council of the said Shire of Keilor, carry on the business of a hawker or itinerant trader dealing in foodstuffs or flowers between the hours of Nine a.m. and Six p.m. on Sunday, Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, Friday, and Saturday in each week in or upon the undermentioned streets and road within such Shire, viz.:—

Macedon-street (known as the Calder Highway),

Recursive (known as the Caider Highway),
Kennedy-street,
Arundel-road (that portion fronting Keilor Recreation
Reserve on east side),
situated within the Township of Keilor.

3. No child (as defined by the Factories and Shops Act 1928) shall be employed as a street hawker or itinerant trader, or be permitted to manage or occupy a stand in any street, road, or public place within the said Shire of Keilor.

4. Any person who by wilful act or default contrary thereto shall, on conviction, for every first offence be liable to a penalty not exceeding Five pounds, and for every subsequent offence to a penalty not exceeding. Twenty pounds.
