Factories and Shops Act 1928 (No. 3677).

## DETERMINATION OF THE MOTOR DRIVERS BOARD.

Note.—This Determination on the 31st March, 1931, applied to the following parts of Victoria, namely:—The Metropolitan District as defined in the Factories and Shops Act 1928 (No. 3677) and the Order in Council thereunder, and such portions of the City of Sandringham as are not within the said district; the cities of Ballarat, Bendigo, Geelong, Geelong West, and Warrnambool; the town of Newtown and Chilwell; and the boroughs of Eaglehawk and Sebastopol.

IN accordance with the provisions of the Factories and Shops Act 1928 (No. 3677), the Wages Board appointed to "determine the lowest prices or rates which may be paid to persons employed—

(1) driving mechanically-propelled vehicles hired or plying for hire:
(2) cleaning or attending to the running requirements (not including repairs) of mechanically-propelled vehicles which are—
(a) hired, plying for hire, or used in connexion with a trade or business;
(b) stalled in a public garage or in an engineer's workshop"—
has made the following Determination, namely:—

Norm.—On the 2nd July, 1923, the powers of the Motor Drivers Board were extended to enable it to fix the lowest rates which may be paid to persons employed as Conductors in connexion with mechanically-propelled passenger vehicles hired or plying for hire

(1) That on the 31st March, 1931, the last previous Determination of this Board shall be revoked and replaced by this Determination.
