PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c., &c.

I, THE Lieutenant-Governor of the State of Victoria, in the Commonwealth of Australia, do hereby declare that I have this day assented, in His Majesty's name, to the Bills passed by the Parliament of the said State, the titles whereof are hereunder set forth, that is to say:—

- No. 4055. "An Act to further amend Section Twenty-eight of the *Financial Emergency Act 1931*."
 No. 4056. "An Act to provide for the Payment by Instalments in respect of Taxes on Income and to amend the *Income Tax Acts*."
 No. 4057. "An Act to provide further Moneys for the Relief of Unemployment and to limit the Duration of the Stamps (*Unemployment Relief*) Acts and for other purposes."

DATE OF COMING INTO OPERATION.

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c., &c.

WHEREAS by an Act of the Parliament of the State of Victoria passed in the twenty-third year of the reign of His present Majesty King George V., intitled the *Income Tax Acts Amendment Act 1932*, it is amongst other things enacted that Part I. of the said Act shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by Proclamation of the Governor in Council published in the *Government Gazette*: Now therefore I, the Lieutenant-Governor of the State of Victoria, acting by and with the advice of the Executive Council thereof, do by
