CLOSER SETTLEMENT COMMISSION APPOINTED, ETC.

At the Executive Council Chamber, Melbourne, the sixteenth day of February, 1933. .

Esquire, to be, as on and from the first day of March, 1933, the members of the Closer Settlement Commission referred to in paragraph (a) of sub-section (2) of section 4 of the Closer Settlement Act 1932, and doth hereby appoint the said Clive McPherson, Esquire, to be Chairman of the said Commission, and the said Norman Harty Malcolm, Esquire, to be senior to the said John Allan Aird, Esquire, with respect to the aforesaid appointment.

N pursuance of the powers conferred by the Oloser Settlement Act 1932, His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor of the State of Victoria, by and with the advice of the Executive Council thereof, doth by this Order hereby appoint the hour of half-past Ten o'clock in the forenoon of the first day of March, 1933, as the time, and the Public Offices, Treasury Gardens, Melbourne, as the place at which the Closer Settlement Commission shall hold its first meeting.

And the Honorable Albert Arthur Dunstan, His Majesty's Commissioner of Crown Lands and Survey for the State of Victoria, shall give the necessary directions herein accordingly.
