*Public Works Committee Act 1935.*

DATE OF COMING INTO OPERATION.

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor, as Deputy for His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria, and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c., &c.,

WHEREAS by an Act of the Parliament of the State of Victoria passed in the twenty-sixth year of the reign of his present Majesty King George V., intitled the *Public Works Committee Act 1935*, it is amongst other things enacted that the said Act shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by Proclamation of the Governor in Council published in the *Government Gazette*: Now therefore I, the Lieutenant-Governor, as Deputy for His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria, acting by and with the advice of the Executive Council thereof, do by this my Proclamation fix Wednesday, the fourteenth day of August, One thousand nine hundred and thirty-five, as the date upon which the said *Public Works Committee Act 1935* shall come into operation in the said State of Victoria.

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the State of Victoria aforesaid, at Melbourne, this fourteenth day of August, in the year of our Lord, One thousand nine hundred and thirty-five, and in the twenty-sixth year of the reign of His Majesty King George V.
