INCOME TAX ACTS AMENDMENT ACT 1936 (No. 4375).

DATE OF COMING INTO OPERATION.

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c.

WHEREAS by an Act of the Parliament of the State of Victoria passed in the first year of the reign of His present Majesty King Edward VIII., intituled the Income Tax Acts Amendment Act 1936, it is amongst other things enacted that the said Act shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by Proclamation of the Governor in Council published in the Government Gazette: Now therefore I, the Governor of the State of Victoria, in the Commonwealth of Australia, by and with the advice of the Executive Council thereof, do by this my Proclamation fix Monday, the twenty-eighth day of September. One thousand nine hundred and thirty-six, as the day upon which the said Income Tax Acts Amendment Act 1936 shall come into operation.

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the State of Victoria aforesaid, at Melbourne, this twenty-eighth day of September, in the year of our Lord One thousand nine hundred and thirty-six, and in the first year of the reign of His Majesty King Edward VIII.
