# AREAS OF LANDS COMPRISED IN CERTAIN CLASSES DIMINISHED OR INCREASED.

## PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c., &c.

WHEREAS by the Land Act 1928 it is amongst other things enacted that the Governor in Council may, by Proclamation to be published in the Government Gacette, at any time diminish or increase the area of land comprised in any of the classes mentioned in Part I., Division I, section 5, of the said Land Act 1928, but that the area of lands which may be sold by auction (Class 6) shall not be increased except as in certain cases in the said Act provided: Now therefore I, the Governor of the State of Victoria, in the Commonwealth of Australia, by and with the advice of the Executive Council of the said State, and in accordance with the provisions of sections 94 and 117 of the Land Act 1928 aforesaid, do hereby diminish or increase (as the case may be) the areas of Crown lands comprised in Classes 1, 3, 6, 7, and 8 respectively of the classes mentioned in section 5 of the Land Act 1928 aforesaid to the extent set forth in the subjoined Schedules (that is to say):—

HIS Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria, by and with the advice of the Executive Council thereof, in pursuance of the powers conferred by section 4 of the Notor Omnibus Act 1928 (No. 3742), doth by this Order prescribe a further route within the metropolitan area along which Motor Omnibuses for which "regular service" licences are granted may ply for hire, also sections and terminal points and stopping places on such toute, time-tables to be observed by owners of motor omnibuses plying for hire, fares to be charged, and the maximum number of motor omnibuses which may be licensed to ply for hire on such prescribed route, as set forth in detail in the schedule hereunder:—

# Stopping Places on Route.

Pending the fixing of stopping places, motor omnibuses shall only stop for the purpose of taking up and setting down passengers at such points upon the route as may be convenient, and in such manner as not to interfere with or endanger the general traffic of the streets or roads or the safety of passengers in motor omnibuses.

## Fares to be Charged.

The farcs to be charged for children under twelve years of age (other than children under three years of age carried on passenger's lap, who shall be carried free) shall be one-half of the rares charged for adult passengers calculated to the nearest higher penny.

His Excellency doth by this Order further provide, in pursuance of the powers conferred by section 15 (1) (b) of the Motor Omnibus Act 1928 (No. 3742), that the Orders in Council approved by His Excellency the Governor in Council on the 18th December, 1934, 21st February, 1935, 20th March, 1935, 27th May, 1935, 17th June, 1935, and 2nd September, 1935, prescribing routes within the metropolitan area along which motor omnibuses for which "regular service" licences are granted under the provisions of the said Act may ply for hire shall be amended in the manner following:—

    (b) "Made portion of any carriage way" shall mean and include such portion of any street, road, or lane as has been treated with metal. gravel, or bituminous
  - (c) "Water-table" shall mean the drains used for the purpose of draining the carriage way along each side of and nearest to the made portion of any
  - carriage way.

    (d) "Draw or trail"—A person shall be deemed to draw or trail any sledge, timber, or other heavy material fi animal or mechanical power be used for that purpose, and such animal or mechanical power be controlled by any power.

    "Heavy materials" shall mean and include ploughs. harrows, scoops, or cultivators.
