Factories and Shops Acts.

DETERMINATION OF THE FARRIERS BOARD.

NOTE.—This Determination on 29th December, 1937, applied to the following parts of Victoria, namely:—The Metropolitan District as defined in the Factories and Shops Acts and the Order in Council thereunder, and such portion of the city of Sandringham as is not included within the said district; the cities of Ballarat, Bendigo, Geelong, Geelong West, and Warrnambool; the town of Newtown and Chilwell; and the boroughs of Eaglehawk and Sebastopol.

IN accordance with the provisions of the Factories and Shops Acts, the Wages Board appointed to "determine the lowest prices or rates which may be paid to any person or persons, or classes of persons, employed in the process, trade, or business of a farrier," has made the following Determination, namely:—

(1) That on the 29th December, 1937, the last previous Determination of this Board shall be revoked and replaced by this Determination.

PROPORTION (within any place).
One apprentice to every three or fraction of three workers receiving not less than 102s. 8d. per week of 44 hours.
One improver to every six workers receiving not less than 102s. 8d. per week of 44 hours.

(3) TIMES OF BEGINNING AND ENDING WORK within the Metropolitan District as defined in the Factories and Shops Acts:—

Time of Beginning.	Time of Ending.
6.30 a.m.	8.30 a.m. on Saturdays.
6.30 a.m.	5 p.m. on the other working days of the week.

(4) OVERTIME.—The following rates shall be paid for all work done:—

(A) Within the Metropolitan District as defined in the Factories and Shops Acts:—

1. Outside the times of beginning and ending work:—

On Saturdays—

Between 8.30 a.m. and 11 a.m. Time and a half.

2. Within the hours fixed as the times of beginning and ending work in excess of 44 hours in any week Double time.

(B) In any other place:—

In excess of 44 hours in any week Time and a half.

(5) SUNDAYS.—Treble time shall be paid for all work done on Sundays.

(6) HOLIDAYS.—All employees shall be entitled to the following Holidays without deduction of pay:—The days observed as Australia Day, Good Friday, Easter Monday, Labour Day, King's Birthday, Royal Agricultural Show Day (in localities mentioned in the Twelfth Schedule to the Public Service Act 1928), Melbourne Cup Day (Metropolitan Area only), Christmas Day, Boxing Day, and New Year's Day. Any employee who is absent without leave on the last working day prior to a holiday or who does not resume work on the first working day after the holiday shall not be entitled to holiday pay.

(7) DAY AND LATEST HOURS FOR PAYMENT OF WAGES.—The day and latest hour when payment of wages is to be made shall be Friday at 4.30 p.m.
