Factories and Shops Acts.

## DETERMINATION OF THE SAND PIT BOARD.

NOTE.—This Determination on the 9th December, 1938, applied to the whole of the State of Victoria.

IN accordance with the provisions of the Factories and Shops Acts, the Wages Board which since the 12th November, 1928, has had the power to "determine the lowest prices or rates which may be paid to any persons employed in connexion with—A sand pit or a gravel pit at labouring work, excavating, handling, or removing sand or gravel for trade or sale, or excavating, handling, or removing sand or gravel for the construction or the maintenance of roads, but not including persons subject to the jurisdiction of the Carters Board," has made the following determination, namely:—

(1) That on the 9th December, 1938, the previous Determinations of the Sand Pit Board shall be revoked and replaced by this Determination.
