NOTICE.

**P**URSUANT to the provisions of the Forests Acts, I, Albert Eli Lind, His Majesty's Minister of Forests in the State of Victoria, do hereby revoke the notice issued under my hand on the 13th March, 1940,

- (a) prohibiting absolutely the use of fire in the open air, and,
  - (b) suspending any or all leases, licences, permits, or authorities granted under the Forests Acts for the felling, conversion, or removal of forest produce—
- within the Counties of—

Bogong.	Polwarth.
Buln Buln.	Tanjil.
Delatite.	Wonnangatta.
