Factories and Shops Acts.

## DETERMINATION OF THE BILLPOSTERS BOARD.

NOTE.—This Determination applies to the following parts of Victoria, namely:—The Metropolitan District as defined in the Factories and Shops Acts and the Order in Council thereunder; such portions of the City of Sandringham as are not included within the said Metropolitan District; the cities of Ballarat, Bendigo, Geelong, Geelong West, Sandringham, and Warrnambool: the town of Newtown and Chilwell; and the boroughs of Eaglehawk and Sebastopol.

IN accordance with the provisions of the Factories and Shops Acts the Wages Board appointed "to determine the lowest prices or rates which may be paid to any person or persons or classes of persons employed in the process, trade, business, or occupation of billposting," has made the following Determination, namely:—

(1) That on the 5th September, 1940, the last previous Determination of this Board shall be revoked and replaced by this

<sup>(3)</sup> CASUAL LABOUR.—Casual employees (i.e., persons employed during any week for not more than 24 hours) shall be paid at

(5) Overtime.—Any employee who works in any week for any time in excess of 48 hours shall be paid for such extra time at the rate of time and a half.

(6) Special Rates.—Double time shall be the special rate for all work done on Sunday, New Year's Day, Australia Day (26th January), Good Friday, Easter Saturday, Easter Monday, Labour Day (21st April), King's Birthday, Christmas Day, and Boxing Day; but if any other day be by Act of Parliament or Proclamation substituted for any of the above-named holidays, the special rate shall only be payable for work done on the day so substituted.
