COMMONWEALTH NATIONAL SECURITY (GENERAL) REGULATIONS.

STATE OF VICTORIA.

CONTROL OF LIFTS ORDER.

ORDER No. 39.

WHEREAS by Regulation 35A of the Commonwealth National Security (General) Regulations it is provided inter alia that the Premier of any State, after consultation with the Minister of State for Home Security or an officer of the Department of Home Security authorized by that Minister to act on his behalf and with the Commandant of a Military District or an officer authorized by the Minister of State for Defence Co-ordination or the Minister of State for the Army to act on behalf of such Commandant, may by Order make such provision as he deems necessary to protect the persons and property of the civil population in that State or any part thereof in case of emergency:

Now therefore I, Albert Arthur Dunstan, Premier of the State of Victoria, having duly held such consultations, do hereby make the following Order:-

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Control of Lifts Order (Victoria) Citation. No. 3.
- 2. Clause 3 of the Control of Lifts Order (Victoria) as amended of lifts at the Control of Lifts Order (Victoria) No. 2 is revoked. by the Control of Lifts Order (Victoria) No. 2 is revoked.

- 3. Clause 4 of the Control of Lifts Order (Victoria) is amended Immobilisation by omitting sub-clause (3) and inserting in its stead the following air raids. sub-clause :-
 - "(3) Where in pursuance of paragraph (a) of sub-clause (1) of this clause a hydraulic lift is being taken to the lowest landing of the building such lift may be used to evacuate persons from upper floors."
- 4. Clause 5 of the Control of Lifts Order (Victoria) is amended by Inspection of chamaged lifts. omitting the words "some competent person" and inserting in their stead the expression "an inspector of lifts under the Lifts Regulation Act 1928 of the State of Victoria".

5. Clause 6 of the Control of Lifts Order (Victoria) is amended by Testing of hydraulio omitting the words "inspected by some competent person once in every month" and inserting in their stead the words "tested by some competent person once in every three months".
