## COMMONWEALTH NATIONAL SECURITY (GENERAL) REGULATIONS.

STATE OF VICTORIA.

### PROTECTION OF PUBLIC PROPERTY ORDER.

ORDER No. 15.

**W**HEREAS by Regulation 35A of the Commonwealth National Security (General) Regulations it is provided *inter alia* that the Premier of any State, after consultation with the Minister of State for Home Security or an officer of the Department of Home Security authorized by that Minister to act on his behalf and with the Commandant of a Military District or an officer authorized by the Minister of State for Defence Co-ordination or the Minister of State for the Army to act on behalf of such Commandant, may by Order make such provision as he deems necessary to protect the persons and property of the civil population in that State or any part thereof in case of emergency:

Now therefore I, Albert Arthur Dunstan, Premier of the State of Victoria, having duly held such consultations, do hereby make the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Protection of Public Property Order (Victoria). Citation.

2. In this Order, unless inconsistent with the context or subject-matter, "Authority" means any Authority within the meaning of the Water Acts, any Sewerage Authority within the meaning of the Sewerage Districts Acts, the Melbourne and Metropolitan Board of Works, the Geelong Waterworks and Sewerage Trust, any trust within the meaning of the Mildura Irrigation and Water Trusts Acts, and any municipality controlling waterworks under the Local Government Acts. Definition.

3. Where in the opinion of the Minister administering any Victorian Government Department it is necessary or desirable that any action should be taken for the protection of any property within the jurisdiction of such Minister or of such Department such action may be taken accordingly. Authorization of the taking of necessary steps for protecting Government property.

4. (1) No person shall, except with the permission in writing signed by the secretary or other authorized officer of any Authority, enter upon or be on or in— Waterworks, sewerage works, &c., to be prohibited areas.

(a) any waterworks or sewerage works of such Authority or any lands vested in or controlled or used by such Authority in connexion with waterworks or sewerage works; or

(b) the water of any reservoir, service basin, tank, dam, or channel vested in or controlled by such Authority in connexion with waterworks or sewerage works.

Saving. (2) Nothing in the foregoing provisions of this clause of this Order shall prevent the *bonâ fide* use of—

- (a) any public road;
- (b) any land or any estate interest or right in or with respect to land by any person entitled thereto; or
- (c) any boat-landing established at the commencement of this Order.

Certain areas on or near reservoirs to be prohibited areas. 5. (1) No person shall, except with the permission in writing signed by the secretary or other authorized officer of the State Rivers and Water Supply Commission, enter upon or be on or in—

- (a) the water of any reservoir referred to in the Schedule to this Order within one-half mile up-stream from any dam or embankment of such reservoir; or
- (b) any dam or embankment or outlet works of any such reservoir or any area within one hundred yards of any such dam or embankment or outlet works.

Saving. (2) Nothing in the foregoing provisions of this clause of this Order shall prevent the *bonâ fide* use of—

- (a) any public road; or
- (b) any boat-landing, established at the commencement of this Order, on the Eildon Reservoir, which is situate within one-half mile of the embankment of such reservoir.
