Factories and Shops Acts.

DETERMINATION OF THE TAR AND BITUMEN BOARD ADJUSTED PURSUANT TO SECTION 21 OF THE FACTORIES AND SHOPS ACT 1934 (No. 4275).

I, Raymond Henry Beers, Secretary for Labour, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the Factories and Shops Acts and in consequence of the provisions of the Determination of the Tar and Bitumen Board published in Government Gazette No. 366 of the 31st December, 1941, hereby issue an adjusted Determination showing the adjusted wages rates to operate from the beginning of the first pay period to commence in November, 1943.

Clause (2) of the Determination published in Government Gazette No. 366 of the 31st December, 1941, shall be replaced by the following clause:—
