DEATH OF THE HONOURABLE HERBERT MICHAEL CREMEAN, M.L.A.

THE Premier, with feelings of profound regret, announces to the public the decease, to-day, the 24th instant, at East Melbourne, in this State, of the Honourable Herbert Michael Cremean, M.L.A.

His Grace, the Archbishop of Melbourne, the Most Reverend D. Mannix, D.D., LL.D., will preside at the Solemn Requiem Mass which will be celebrated at St. Patrick's Cathedral, Melbourne, on Friday, 25th May, at 10.30 o'clock a.m., by the Very Reverend Arthur F. Fox, Administrator of the Cathedral.

At a Service in St. Patrick's Cathedral commencing at 2.30 o'clock p.m. a panegyric will be preached by the Very Reverend Arthur F. Fox. His Grace, Archbishop Mannix, will give the final blessing over the remains.

The Cortège will move from the Cathedral at 2.50 o'clock p.m., via Spring, Victoria and Lygon Streets to the Melbourne General Cemetery.
