REGULATIONS.—PART III.—SALARIES,
INCREMENTS, AND ALLOWANCES.

THE Public Service Board, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Public Service Act 1946*, hereby amends the Public Service (Public Service Board) Regulations as follows:—

From Regulation 48A (4) and Regulation 49 (4) the following words are deleted:—

“ Provided that the first annual increment payable to officers in receipt of the minimum salary of Class ‘A’ shall be £39.”

After Regulation 60 (3) the following sub-regulation is inserted:—

“(4) The Board may determine that the provisions of this Regulation shall be applied, with such restric-

tions and limitations as it may see fit to impose, to any officer in the Administrative Division or the Professional Division appointed prior to the 29th October, 1946, as if this Regulation had been in operation for the duration of the officer's service in Class ‘E’ or in the lowest class in the Clerical or Professional Divisions under the provisions of the *Public Service Act 1928*.”

These Regulations shall have effect as on and from the 5th October, 1947.
