## REGULATIONS.—PART III.—SALARIES, INCREMENTS, AND ALLOWANCES.

THE Public Service Board, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Public Service Act 1946*, hereby amends the Public Service (Public Service Board) Regulations as follows:—

Regulation 50 is revoked and the following Regulation inserted in lieu thereof:—

“50 (1) The several offices comprising the Technical and General Division shall be those specified in the Second and Seventh Schedules to these Regulations, and the annual amount or range of salary assigned to each such office shall be that entered opposite the name thereof in such Schedules.

(2) The annual increment payable to officers of the Technical and General Division shall, unless otherwise provided in the Second or Seventh Schedules, be £13. Provided that no officer shall receive any increment which will raise his salary beyond the prescribed maximum rate for the office.”

This Regulation shall have effect as on and from the 2nd November, 1947.
