DETERMINATION OF A WAGES BOARD ADJUSTED PURSUANT TO SECTION 21 OF THE FACTORIES AND SHOPS ACT 1934 (No. 4275).

3. **SHIFTS.**—That work performed except on a day shift as defined in clause 16 herein shall be paid for at the rate prescribed for day-shift work, with the addition of $7\frac{1}{2}$ per cent.

Clauses (4) to (18) inclusive of the Determination published in *Government Gazette* No. 144 of the 17th July, 1943, shall remain in force.
