ESSENTIAL SERVICES ACT 1948.

At Government House, Melbourne, the sixteenth day of November, 1948.

PRESENT:

His Excellency the Governor of Victoria.

DATE OF OPERATION OF SUB-SECTION (1) OF SECTION 10 OF THE ESSENTIAL SERVICES ACT 1948.

WHEREAS it is enacted by sub-section (3) of section 10 of the Essential Services Act 1948 that sub-section (1) of the said section 10 shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by Order of the Governor in Council published in the Government Gazette, which day shall be subsequent to the date of the first publication of Regulations made under the said section 10: And whereas the first publication of such Regulations was made in the Government Gazette of the 15th day of November, 1948: Now therefore His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria in the Commonwealth of Australia, by and with the advice of the Executive Council of the said State, in pursuance of the hereinbefore recited powers and all other powers him thereunto enabling, doth by this Order fix the 16th day of November, 1948, as the day upon which sub-section (1) of section 10 of the Essential Services Act 1948 shall come into operation.

And the Honorable John Gladstone Black McDonald, as Deputy for the Honorable the Premier of the State of Victoria, shall give the necessary directions herein accordingly.
