Clauses (4) to (32) and Schedule "A" inclusive of Part I. and clauses (4) to (35) and Schedule "A" inclusive of Part II. except that in Schedule "A" of Part I. the expression "Provided that in addition to the piecework rates set out in this schedule, a pieceworker shall be paid 4s. for each full week worked or a pro rata amount according to the time actually worked if less than a full week is worked," shall be replaced by the following:—"Provided that in addition to the piecework rates set out in this schedule, a pieceworker shall be paid 25s. for each full week worked or a pro rata amount according to the time actually worked if less than a full week is worked," and in Schedule "A" of Part II. the expression "In addition to the piecework rates set out in this Schedule a pieceworker shall be paid 1s. 1d. for each full week worked or a pro rata amount according to the time actually worked if less than a full week is worked" shall be replaced by the following:—"In addition to the piecework rates set out in this Schedule a pieceworker shall be paid 24s. 3d. for each full week worked or a pro rata amount according to the time actually worked if less than a full week is worked."
