Factories and Shops Acts.

DETERMINATION OF A WAGES BOARD ADJUSTED PURSUANT TO SECTION 21 OF THE FACTORIES AND SHOPS ACT 1934 (No. 4275).

I, Raymond Henry Beers, Secretary for Labour, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the Factories and Shops Acts, hereby make and issue the following adjusted Determination of the Wages Board referred to hereunder showing adjusted rates and prices to operate from the beginning of the first pay period to commence in February, 1948.

BREAD CARTERS BOARD.

Clauses 1 of Part 1, 1 of Part 2, 1 of Part 3, and I of Part 4 of the Determination made on the 8th January, 1948, and in more on the 23rd January, 1948, shall be replaced by the following clauses:--

The Metropolitan District as defined in the Factories and Shops Acts, and the Orders in Council thereunder, and such portion of the Shire of Doncaster and Templestowe as is not included within the said District; the cities of Ballarat, Bendigo, Chelsea, Geelong, Geelong West, Mordialloc, and Warrnambool: the town of Newtown and Chilwell; the boroughs of Eaglehawk and Sebastopol; the township of Kangaroo Flat, in the Shires of Marong and of Strathfieldsaye; the township of Spring Gully, in the Shire of Strathfieldsaye; such portion of the Shire of Broadmeadows as is south of Somerton-road; the Shire of Dandenong; the Doutta Galla Riding of the Shire of Keilor and such portion of the Maribyrnoug Riding of the said Shire as is within 3 miles of the Starbost Office; the Shire of Mulgrave; such portions of the Shire of South Barwon and of the Moorpanyal Riding of the Shire of Corio as are within a radius of 5 miles of the Geelong Post Office; and such portions of the Shire of Werribee as are within a radius of 3 miles of the Altona Post Office.
