## DETERMINATION OF A WAGES BOARD ADJUSTED PURSUANT TO SECTION 21 OF THE FACTORIES AND SHOPS ACT 1934 (No. 4275).

I, Raymond Henry Beers, Secretary for Labour, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the Factories and Shops Acts, hereby make and issue the following adjusted Determination of the Wages Board referred to hereunder showing adjusted rates and prices to operate from the beginning of the first pay period to commence in February, 1948.

### MARINE STORES BOARD.

Clause 2 of the Determination made on the 8th December, 1947, and in force as from the beginning of the first pay period to commence on or after the 1st January, 1948, shall be replaced by the following clause:—

#### PROPORTION.

*Apprentices.*—One apprentice to every three or fraction of three workers receiving not less than the minimum wage.

*Improvers.*—One improver to every three workers receiving not less than the minimum wage.

In the above amounts a special war allowance of 3s. per week is included in each.

Clauses, other than clause 2, of the said Determination shall remain in force.
