DETERMINATION OF A WAGES BOARD ADJUSTED PURSUANT TO SECTION 21 OF THE FACTORIES AND SHOPS ACT 1934 (No. 4275).

OTHER EMPLOYEES.

Provided that a person first entering the trade between the ages of 18 years and 21 years (both inclusive) shall be deemed for the first two
years of service to be one year less than his or her actual age, and may be paid accordingly. Clauses, other than clause 2, of the said Determination shall remain in force.
