DETERMINATION OF A WAGES BOARD ADJUSTED PURSUANT TO SECTION 21 OF THE FACTORIES AND SHOPS ACT 1934 (No. 4275).

Clauses, other than clause 2, of the said Determination shall remain in force, provided that in lieu of the additional amounts prescribed in Note (a) to Parts I. and II. of the piecework schedule in Clause 14 there shall be substituted the following amounts for males and females respectively:—(a) 38s. 6d. and 20s. 3d. in Part I., and (b) 39s. 9d. and 20s. 3d. in Part II.
