#### DETERMINATION OF A WAGES BOARD ADJUSTED PURSUANT TO SECTION 21 OF THE FACTORIES AND SHOPS ACT 1934 (No. 4275).

I, Raymond Henry Beers, Secretary for Labour, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the Factories and Shops Acts, hereby make and issue the following adjusted Determination of the Wages Board referred to hereunder showing adjusted rates and prices to operate from the beginning of the first pay period to commence in August, 1948.

## CIGAR TRADE BOARD.

Clauses 2, 3, and 4 of the Determination made on the 12th February, 1948, and in force as from the beginning of the first pay period to commence on or after the 25th February, 1948, shall be replaced by the following clauses:—

APPRENTICES AND IMPROVERS. Wages per Week of 40 Hours. Number (in any place). Making cigars or sorting and packing cigars :-APPRENTICES. One male apprentice to every three or fraction of three male workers receiving not less than the APPRENTICES. Experienceon three minimum wage.
