Factories and Shops Acts.

DETERMINATION OF A WAGES BOARD ADJUSTED PURSUANT TO SECTION 21 OF THE FACTORIES AND SHOPS ACT 1934 (No. 4275).

One apprentice to every three or fraction of three workers receiving not less than the minimum wage.

An indenture of apprenticeship has been prescribed by the Board.

Improvers.

Two improvers to each adult worker receiving not less than 154s. 6d. per week of 40 hours in the case of a male adult and 92s. 0d. per week of 40 hours in the case of a female adult.
