#### DETERMINATION OF A WAGES BOARD ADJUSTED PURSUANT TO SECTION 21 OF THE FACTORIES AND SHOPS ACT 1934 (No. 4275).

I, Raymond Henry Beers, Secretary for Labour, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the Factories and Shops Acts, hereby make and issue the following adjusted Determination of the Wages Board referred to hereunder showing adjusted rates and prices to operate from the beginning of the first pay period to commence in November, 1949.

A Zone Manager shall, in addition to his ordinary wage, be entitled to the following allowance for each additional theatre, theatrette, or concert hall supervised:—

First Schedule.
£1 per week with a maximum of £4 per week.

Second Schedule.

15s. per week with a maximum of £3 per week.

Third Schedule.

10s. per week with a maximum of £2 per week.

Fourth Schedule.

7s. 6d. per week with a maximum of £1 10s, per week.

(b) Casual Employees.

A casual employee is one engaged and paid as such. A casual employee for working ordinary time shall be paid per hour one-fortieth of the appropriate weekly wage with the addition of 20 per cent. with a minimum payment as for 4 hours.

Clauses, other than clause 2, of the said Determination shall remain in force.
