DETERMINATION OF A WAGES BOARD ADJUSTED PURSUANT TO SECTION 21 OF THE FACTORIES AND SHOPS ACT 1934 (No. 4275).

I, Raymond Henry Beers, Secretary for Labour, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the Factories and Shops Acts, hereby make and issue the following adjusted Determination of the Wages Board referred to hereunder showing adjusted rates and prices to operate from the beginning of the first pay period to commence in November, 1949.

(iv) Additional Amounts Payable for Long Service with an Employer.

An employer who has been in the continuous service of an employer or any successor, or assignee, or transmittee of such employer, shall, in addition to the rates hereinbefore prescribed, be entitled to receive as part of his ordinary wages, amounts as follows:—

(a) for drivers of vehicles on regular services-

After not less than two years, but less than five years of such service an additional 5s. per week; After five years or more of such service, an additional 10s. per week.

(b) for all other employees-

After two years or more of such service, an additional õs. per week.

Clauses, other than clause 2, of the said Determination shall remain in force.
