PRICES REGULATION ORDER No. 127.

PETROLEUM AND SHALE PRODUCTS.—MOTOR SPIRIT.

IN pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by the Prices Regulation Acts, I, John Francis Waldron, Prices Decontrol Commissioner, hereby make the following Order:—

*Citation.*

1. This Order may be cited as Prices Regulation Order No. 127.

*Revocation.*

2. Prices Regulation Order No. 2091, as amended by Prices Regulation Order Nos. 2236, 2512, 2620, 2791, 3052, 3194, 3275, 3331, made under the Commonwealth National Security (Prices) Regulations, is hereby revoked.

*Definitions.*

3. In this Order, unless the contrary intention appears—
  - “Motor Spirit” means a liquid petroleum or shale product normally marketed for use as fuel in internal combustion engines with spark ignition, excluding power kerosene but including such motor spirit blended with distillate from coal products or with alcohol.
  - “Metropolitan Area” means all that area comprised within a radius of 20 miles from the General Post Office, Melbourne.

*Maximum Price.*

4. I fix and declare the maximum price at which motor spirit may be sold by retail to be—
  - (a) in the Metropolitan Area—three shillings per gallon;
  - (b) outside the Metropolitan Area—the sum of the purchase price paid or payable to the wholesale seller plus three pence three farthings per gallon. Provided that where the maximum price so calculated results in a price not exactly divisible by one half-penny, the maximum price may be determined at the nearest upward half-penny.

*Fixation of Maximum Prices by Notice.*

5. Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions of this Order, I declare the maximum price at which motor spirit specified in a notice given in pursuance of this clause may be sold by any person to whom such notice is given to be such price as is fixed by the Prices Decontrol Commissioner by notice in writing to that person.

## FIREWOOD.—GEELONG.

IN pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by the Prices Regulation Acts, I, John Francis Waldron, Prices Decontrol Commissioner, hereby make the following Order:—

*Citation.*

1. This Order may be cited as Prices Regulation Order No. 128.

*Revocation.*

2. (1) Prices Regulation Order No. 3412, issued under the Commonwealth National Security (Prices) Regulations, is hereby revoked.  
(2) Nothing contained in Prices Regulation Order No. 102 shall apply to firewood to which this Order applies.

*Application.*

3. This Order shall not apply to the sale of Mallee Roots.

*Definitions.*

4. In this Order, unless the contrary intention appears—  
“Geelong area” means—  
(a) all that area comprised within a radius of 5 miles from the principal Post Office at Geelong, Victoria, and  
(b) all that area comprised within a radius of 5 miles from the Post Office at Queenscliff, Victoria;  
“by wholesale” means, in relation to any sale of firewood, that such sale is—  
(a) a sale to a person for resale,  
(b) a sale to a Commonwealth or State Government Department, or  
(c) a sale to and for the use of an industrial undertaking;  
“ton” means 2,240 lb. avoirdupois;  
“cwt.” means 112 lb. avoirdupois.

*Maximum Prices.—Sales by Wholesale.*

5. I fix and declare the maximum price at which firewood of the kinds specified in the First Schedule to this Order may be sold by wholesale in the Geelong area to be—

- (a) where such firewood is sold by weight—the price per ton specified in the second column of such Schedule;
- (b) where such firewood is sold by volume—the price specified in the third column of such Schedule;
- (c) where such firewood is sold by the railway truck—the price per ton, as specified in the second column of such Schedule, for the railway standard weight of such truck; or
- (d) where such firewood is sold by the load or other than as set out in paragraphs (a), (b), or (c) of this clause—the price per ton weight of the firewood actually contained in the load or the price per cubic foot of the volume actually contained in the load, as specified in the second and third columns of such Schedule, whichever is the lesser:

Provided that where delivery is made to the purchaser's premises, the maximum prices so fixed by the foregoing provisions of this clause shall be subject to an increase of—

- (a) 5s. per ton weight; or
- (b) in the case of milled wood—3s. 4d. per 40 cubic feet; or
- (c) in the case of long wood—3s. 4d. per 50 cubic feet as the case requires.

*Maximum Prices.—Sales by Retail.*

6. I fix and declare the maximum price at which firewood of the kinds specified in the Second Schedule to this Order may be sold by retail in the Geelong area to be—

- (a) where delivery is made to the purchaser's premises or delivered free on rail Geelong area—
  - (i) where such firewood is sold by weight—the price per cwt. as specified in such Schedule, according to the weight of the firewood comprised in such sale;
  - (ii) where such firewood is sold by volume—the price per 10 cubic feet as specified in such Schedule, according to the volume of the firewood comprised in such sale; or
  - (iii) where such firewood is sold by the load or other than as set out in sub-paragraphs (i) or (ii) above—the price per cwt. of the firewood actually contained in the load, or the price per 10 cubic feet or the volume actually contained in the load, as specified in such Schedule, whichever is the lesser; or
- (b) where delivery is made *ex* fuel yard—the maximum price fixed by the provisions of sub-paragraph (a) of this paragraph, less 3d. per cwt. or 1s. per 10 cubic feet, as the case may be:

Provided that if at the time of any delivery of firewood to a purchaser an invoice or docket specifying the weight or volume of such firewood is not delivered, then I fix and declare the maximum price at which such firewood may be sold to be the price per cwt. of the firewood actually delivered, or the price per 10 cubic feet of the firewood actually delivered, as specified in such Second Schedule, whichever is the lesser.

*Maximum Prices.—Sales by Retail of Split Firewood.*

7. Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions of this Order, I fix and declare the maximum price at which billets of firewood of the kinds specified in the Second Schedule to this Order, and of not more than 4 inches in width may be sold by retail in the Geelong area to be the maximum price fixed by such foregoing provisions for the sale by retail of that kind and length of firewood, plus, in each case, an amount calculated at the rate of 6d. per cwt. or 1s. 9d. per 10 cubic feet, as the case requires.

*Fixation of Maximum Prices by Notice.*

8. Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions of this Order, I declare the maximum price at which firewood specified in a notice given in pursuance of this paragraph may be sold by any person to whom such notice is given to be such price as is fixed by the Commissioner by notice in writing to that person.

IN pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by the Prices Regulation Acts, I, John Francis Waldron, Prices Decontrol Commissioner, hereby make the following Order:—

*Citation.*

1. This Order may be cited as Prices Regulation Order No. 129.

*Application.*

2. This Order shall not apply to the sale of Mallee Roots.

*Revocation.*

3. (1) Prices Regulation Order No. 3410 issued under the Commonwealth National Security (Prices) Regulations is hereby revoked.  
(2) Nothing contained in Prices Regulation Order No. 102 shall apply to firewood to which this Order applies.

*Definitions.*

4. In this Order, unless the contrary intention appears—  
“Ballarat area” means all that area comprised within a radius of 5 miles from the principal Post Office at Ballarat, Victoria;  
“ton” means 2,240 lb. avoirdupois;  
“cwt.” means 112 lb. avoirdupois;  
“by wholesale” means, in relation to any sale of firewood—  
(a) that such sale is a sale to a person for resale;  
(b) that such sale is a sale to a Commonwealth or State Government Department;  
(c) that such sale is a sale to a person, not purchasing for the purpose of resale, who in the three months immediately preceding such sale, purchased from the seller firewood to the value of over £125; or  
(d) that such sale is a sale to and for the use of an industrial undertaking;  
“retail fuel merchant” means, in relation to any sale of firewood, a person—  
(a) who is engaged in the conduct of a retail fuel business;

- (b) is prepared at all times to sell by retail unsold stocks in lots of not less than 1 cwt.; and
- (c) at least 50 per centum of whose sales of firewood during the four weeks immediately preceding such sales were sales by retail.

*Maximum Prices.—Sales by Wholesale.—By Weight or by Volume.*

5. I fix and declare the maximum price at which firewood of any description specified in the First Schedule to this Order may be sold by wholesale in the Ballarat area to be—

- (a) where not delivered in the Ballarat area—the price specified in that Schedule less the usual cost of transporting by rail such firewood to the Ballarat area from the railway siding nearest to the point of delivery;
- (b) where delivered on rail or otherwise in the Ballarat area other than to the purchaser's premises—the price specified in that Schedule;
- (c) where delivered into the purchaser's premises—the price specified in that Schedule plus an amount calculated at the rate of 5s. per ton weight.

*Maximum Prices.—Sales by Wholesale.—By the Railway Truck or any other manner.*

6. (1) I fix and declare the maximum price at which firewood of any of the descriptions specified in the First Schedule to this Order may be sold by wholesale by the railway truck to be the price calculated in accordance with the foregoing provisions of this Order for the railway standard weight of that type of truck for firewood of such description.

(2) I fix and declare the maximum price at which firewood of any of the descriptions specified in the First Schedule to this Order may be sold by wholesale, other than by weight or by volume or by the truck, to be the price fixed by the foregoing provisions of this Order for the sale of that firewood by weight or the price fixed by the foregoing provisions of this Order for the sale of that firewood by volume, whichever is the lesser.

*Maximum Prices.—Sales by Retail.*

7. I fix and declare the maximum price at which firewood of any of the descriptions specified in the Second Schedule to this Order may be sold by retail in the Ballarat area to be—

- (a) where delivery is made to the purchaser's premises—the price specified in that Schedule;
- (b) where delivery is not made to the purchaser's premises—the price specified in that Schedule less 1s. 3d. per 10 cubic feet:

Provided that where such firewood is split into billets of not more than 4 inches in width at the request of the purchaser, the maximum prices so fixed shall be increased by an amount calculated at the rate of 1s. 9d. per 10 cubic feet.

*Inter-retail Sales.*

8. Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions of this Order, I fix and declare the maximum price at which firewood of any of the descriptions specified in the First Schedule to this Order may be sold by a bona fide retail fuel merchant to any other person who sells firewood by retail to be the maximum price fixed by the foregoing provisions of this Order for the sale of that firewood by wholesale plus—

- (a) where delivery is made at destination siding—
  - (i) for sales of I.B. railway truck lots—10s. per I.B. truck;
  - (ii) for sales of railway truck lots larger than I.B. truck lots—20s. per truck;

- (iii) for sales other than railway truck lots—3s. per ton; and
- (b) where delivery is made into the fuel yard of the purchaser—
  - (i) 8s. per ton (which sum shall include the 5s. per ton allowable in accordance with paragraph (c) of clause 5 of this Order); or
  - (ii) 5s. 4d. per 40 cubic feet of firewood in lengths not exceeding 30 inches or 5s. 4d. per 50 cubic feet of firewood in lengths exceeding 30 inches.

*Fixation of Maximum Prices by Notice.*

9. Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions of this Order, I declare the maximum price at which any firewood specified in a notice given in writing in pursuance of this paragraph may be sold by any person to whom such notice is given to be such price as is fixed by the Commissioner by notice in writing to that person.

IN pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by the Prices Regulation Acts, I, John Francis Waldron, Prices Decontrol Commissioner, hereby make the following Order:—

Citation.

1. This Order may be cited as Prices Regulation Order No. 131.

Definitions.

2. In this Order, unless the contrary intention appears—

“Crusader Kitchen and Cooking Utensil” means any article or utensil which is or may be used in the domestic kitchen for the purpose of preparing or serving food and which has been or purports to have been manufactured by Crusader Plate Company Proprietary Limited, 653 Victoria-street, Abbotsford, Victoria.

“Premier Kitchen and Cooking Utensil” means any article or Utensil which is or may be used in the domestic kitchen for the purpose of preparing or serving food and which has been or purports to have been manufactured by Premier Wire Works Proprietary Limited, of 2 Chapel-street, Richmond, Victoria.

“Metropolitan Area” means all that area of Victoria comprised within a radius of 20 miles from the General Post Office, Melbourne.

*Maximum Prices.—Sales by Retail.*

3. I fix and declare the maximum price at which any Crusader or Premier Kitchen and Cooking Utensils may be sold by retail to be—

- (a) in respect of sales for delivery within the metropolitan area, the appropriate price as set out in the Schedule to this Order;
- (b) in respect of sales outside the metropolitan area, the appropriate price set out in the Schedule to this Order, plus the cost of transport (if any) actually incurred by the retailer thereof and properly attributable to the transport of such Crusader or Premier Kitchen and Cooking Utensils to the retailer's place of business.

*Exhibition of Price Tickets.*

4. (1) Every person who sells or has for sale by retail any Crusader or Premier Kitchen and Cooking Utensils the maximum price of which is fixed by or under the provisions of this Order, shall attach to or display with those goods a ticket or label setting forth his selling price thereof.

(2) Any ticket or label required by sub-clause (1) of this clause to be attached to or displayed with any goods shall be in such form as to be easily legible to any person inspecting or viewing those goods and as to be properly associated with such goods.

*Fixation of Maximum Prices by Notice.*

5. Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions of this Order, I declare the maximum price at which any Crusader or Premier Kitchen and Cooking Utensils specified in a notice given in pursuance of this clause may be sold by any person to whom such notice is given to be such price as is fixed by the Commissioner by notice in writing to that person.
