Prices Regulation Acts.

NOTICE TO CERTAIN HOLDERS OF TALLOW TO FURNISH
RETURNS OF TALLOW STOCKS.

IN pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by and under the Prices Regulation Acts, I, Michael Maurice Gloster, Acting Prices Decontrol Commissioner for the State of Victoria, do by this notice require every person who had in his possession or under his control on the first day of January, 1949, any quantity of tallow in excess of 2,240 lb. weight, to furnish to the Prices Decontrol Commissioner at his office, 143-147 Collins-street, Melbourne, on or before the thirty-first day of January, 1949, a return in writing in the appropriate form referred to in the First Schedule to this notice. In every case, the return shall set forth fully and correctly all the relevant information required for the completion of the form and shall be verified by the statutory declaration of the person making the return. In the case of a partnership, the return shall be made by one of the partners thereof, and in the case of a company, by a director thereof or by the secretary thereof.

THE FIRST SCHEDULE.

The appropriate form of return shall be—

- (a) in the case of a tallow manufacturer, the form set out in the Second Schedule to this notice;
- (b) in the case of a margarine manufacturer, the form set out in the Third Schedule to this notice;
- (c) in the case of a soap manufacturer, the form set out in the Fourth Schedule to this notice;
- (d) in the case of an agent or shipper, the form set out in the Fifth Schedule to this notice; and
- (e) in the case of a person not hereinbefore in this Schedule referred to, the form set out in the Sixth Schedule to this notice.
