ACT OF PARLIAMENT.

PROCLAMATION

By the Deputy for His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c., &c.

I, THE Deputy for the Lieutenant-Governor of the State of Victoria, in the Commonwealth of Australia, do hereby declare that I have this day assented, in His Majesty's name, to the Bill passed by the Parliament of the said State, the title whereof is hereunder set forth, that is to say:—

No. 5366. "An Act relating to a Royal Commission to enquire into and report upon the Origins, Aims, Objects, and Funds, of the Communist Party in Victoria and the Operations and Activities in Victoria of that Party and Members thereof and Organizations and Persons associated therewith."

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the State of Victoria aforesaid, at Melbourne, this nineteenth day of May, in the year of our Lord One thousand nine hundred and forty-nine, and in the thirteenth year of the reign of His Majesty King George VI.
