Prices Regulation Act 1948.

PRICES REGULATION ORDER No. 63.

SAWN TIMBER—MELBOURNE.

IN pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by the *Prices Regulation Act 1948*, I, John Francis Waldron, Prices Decontrol Commissioner, hereby make the following Order:—

Citation.

1. This Order may be cited as Prices Regulation Order No. 63.

Revocations.

2. (1) Prices Regulation Order No. 3370 made under Commonwealth National Security (Prices) Regulations is hereby revoked.
- (2) Insofar as it relates to the sale by retail in the Melbourne Metropolitan Area (as defined in this Order) of any sawn timber covered by the provisions of this Order, and insofar as it relates to the supply of any service covered by the provisions of this Order, Prices Regulation Order No. 1181, made under Commonwealth National Security (Prices) Regulations, is hereby revoked.

Definitions.

3. In this Order and the Schedules thereto, unless the contrary intention appears—

“Air-dried” means, in relation to any sawn timber, that such timber has been dried and that the maximum moisture content of any part thereof does not exceed 20 per centum.

“Case quality” means, in relation to any Australian sawn timber, that such timber is sound, sawn true to size, free from wane or want, bad gum pockets, loose or rotten knots, and of a quality suitable for case manufacture.

“Kiln-dried and reconditioned” means, in relation to any sawn timber, that such timber has been dried and that the maximum moisture content of any part thereof does not exceed 14 per centum.

“Melbourne metropolitan area” means all that area of Victoria comprised within a radius of 20 miles from the General Post Office at Melbourne.

“Merchantable quality” or “second quality” means—

- (a) in relation to any Victorian or Tasmanian hardwood timber, that such timber is sound quarter sawn truewood, free from all defects other than—
- (i) on one face, tight gum veins not more than $\frac{3}{32}$ inch wide, with a combined length not exceeding 3 feet per square foot of face area of the board, but 20 per centum thereof shall be allowed 9 feet of the combined length per square foot of the face area of the board;
 - (ii) on the face, three holes not greater than $\frac{1}{16}$ inch in diameter per square foot of face area of the board, not more than three holes being grouped in any four square inches;
 - (iii) on the face, one sound tight knot not greater than $\frac{3}{4}$ inch in diameter per three square feet of the face area of the board;
 - (iv) one inch spring in 12 feet of length;
- (b) in relation to any Western Australian hardwood, that such timber conforms to the requirements and specifications of standard grade issued by the Standards Association of Australia under the title of Technical Standards 0, 10, 11, and 14 to 43-1938 Australian Grading Rules for Jarrah and Karri;
- (c) in relation to any Queensland sawn softwood, that such timber is sound timber, well milled, and free from borers and doze, but may contain sap, sound firm knots, or not more than 5 per centum on the surface of wane.

“Select grade” means, in relation to any sawn hardwood flooring timber, that such timber conforms to the requirements and specifications of select grade sawn hardwood flooring timber issued by the Standards Association of Australia by Interim 202 of September, 1945.

“Select quality” or “first quality” means—

- (a) in relation to any Victorian or Tasmanian hardwood timber other than flooring timber, that such timber is sound quarter sawn truewood free on the face from all defects other than the following tolerance:—
- (i) on the face, tight gum veins not more than $\frac{1}{32}$ inch wide, individual lengths not exceeding 1 inch per square foot of the face area of the board;
 - (ii) on the face, one hole not greater than $\frac{1}{16}$ inch diameter per square foot of face area of the board, not more than three holes being grouped in any four square inches;
 - (iii) one inch spring in any 12 feet of length;
- (b) in relation to Western Australian hardwood, that such timber conforms to the requirements and specifications of “select grade” or “first grade,” as the case may be, issued by the Standards Association of Australia under the title of Technical Standards 0, 10, 11, and 14 to 43-1938 Australian Standard Grading Rules for Jarrah and Karri;
- (c) in relation to Victorian and Queensland softwoods, that such timbers are free from defects likely to impair the strength or appearance of that timber, but that 75 per centum of any parcel of that timber shall consist of boards with one clear face and two sound edges.

“Unseasoned” means, in relation to any sawn timber, that such timber is not air dried or kiln dried and reconditioned.

Fixation of Maximum Prices and Rates.

4. (1) Notwithstanding the provisions of any Prices Regulation Order issued prior to this Order, I fix and declare the maximum price at which any sawn timber specified in the Schedule to this Order may be sold by any person by retail in the Melbourne metropolitan area to be the price specified in that Schedule.

(2) Notwithstanding the provisions of any Prices Regulation Order issued prior to the date of this Order, I fix and declare the maximum rate at which the service of cartage of any sawn timber for which a maximum price is fixed by the foregoing provisions of this Order may be supplied to the purchaser by the seller of that timber to be—

- (a) where the timber in respect of which that service is supplied is ex stock seller's yard—9s. per ton;
- (b) in any other case—9s. per ton, less 3s. per 100 superficial feet thereof.

Provided that where sales are made of a value of less than £2, the maximum prices fixed by the foregoing provisions of this Order shall be subject to an increase of 15 per centum thereof:

Provided further that where payment is made not later than the last day of the month immediately succeeding the month in which delivery is made, the maximum prices and rates fixed by the foregoing provisions of this Order shall, in each case, be subject to a reduction of 2½ per centum thereof.

Prohibition of the Sale of Sawn Timber or Supply of any Service in Connexion Therewith Before Application for Price or Rate.

5. No person shall sell in the Melbourne metropolitan area any sawn timber for the sale of which a maximum price is not fixed by or under the provisions of this Order, or supply in the Melbourne metropolitan area any service in connexion with the sale of such sawn timber, for the supply of which a maximum rate is not fixed by those provisions, unless and until he has made a written request to the Commissioner to fix the maximum price at which such sawn timber may be sold or the maximum rate at which such service may be supplied, and the Commissioner has fixed the maximum price or the maximum rate accordingly.

Delivery of Invoices.

6. Any person who sells any sawn timber by retail in the Melbourne metropolitan area shall deliver with that timber an invoice or docket specifying the following particulars:—

- (a) the name and address of the seller;
- (b) the name and address of the purchaser;
- (c) the address at which that timber is delivered;
- (d) the date of the sale of that timber;
- (e) a full description of that timber, including specie, quality or grade, and size and length, and particulars as to whether the timber is dressed or undressed;
- (f) the quantity of each species, quality or grade, and size and length of that timber;
- (g) full particulars of any service of cartage supplied in connexion with the sale of that timber, including the rate at which such service is supplied;
- (h) the price at which each specie, quality or grade, and size and length is sold;
- (i) particulars of any discounts allowed.

Fixation of Maximum Prices by Notice—Associations.

7. Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions of this Order, I declare the maximum price or rate at which any sawn timber specified in a notice in writing given in pursuance of this paragraph or any service in connexion with the sale of that timber so specified may be sold or supplied by any body or association of persons or member of any such body or association of persons to be such price or rate as is fixed by the Commissioner by notice in writing to that body or association.

Fixation of Maximum Prices or Rates by Notice—Specified Persons.

8. Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions of this Order, I declare the maximum price or rate at which any sawn timber specified in a notice in writing given in pursuance of this paragraph or any service in connexion with the sale of that timber so specified may be sold or supplied by any person to whom such notice is given to be such price or rate as is fixed by the Commissioner by notice in writing to that person.

Prices Regulation Act 1948.

PRICES REGULATION ORDER No. 64.

IMPORTED CROCKERY—EARTHENWARE AND CHINAWARE.

IN pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by the *Prices Regulation Act 1948*, I, John Francis Waldron, Prices Decontrol Commissioner, hereby make the following Order:—

Citation.

1. This Order may be cited as Prices Regulation Order No. 64.

Revocation.

2. Prices Regulation Order No. 2734, issued under the National Security (Prices) Regulations, is hereby revoked.

Application.

3. This Order shall apply to imported crockery specified in the Schedule to this Order.

Definitions.

4. In this Order, unless the contrary intention appears—
 - “Imported crockery” means crockery imported from any source outside the Commonwealth of Australia.
 - “Landed cost” means, in relation to the sale of imported crockery by any person, the aggregate of the purchase price paid or payable by that person to the overseas supplier of those goods after deduction of any trade discount but before deduction of any cash discount, overseas office, or forwarding agent’s charges actually incurred, but not exceeding 2½ per centum on the gross invoice value, insurance, freight, exchange calculated at telegraphic transfer rate, duty, wharfage, stacking charges, customs entry and customs agents’ charges (except insofar as any item of transport from wharf or bond store is concerned), but not including any Sales Tax paid.
 - “Importer’s cost” means landed cost as defined herein, plus 5 per centum thereof for breakages.
 - “Metropolitan area” in this Order means all that area of Victoria comprised within a radius of twenty miles from the General Post Office, Melbourne.

Maximum Prices—Sales by Wholesale.

5. I fix and declare the maximum price at which imported crockery may be sold by wholesale to be—

- (a) in respect of sales for delivery within the metropolitan area—importer's cost plus 25 per centum thereof.
- (b) in respect of sales outside the metropolitan area—importer's cost plus 25 per centum thereof, plus the cost actually incurred in respect of and properly attributable to the transport of the imported crockery from the metropolitan area to the wholesaler's place of business.

Maximum Prices—Sales by Retail.

6. I fix and declare the maximum price at which imported crockery may be sold by retail to be—

- (1) where the imported crockery has been purchased by the retailer from a wholesaler—
 - (a) for sales for delivery within the metropolitan area, the sum of—
 - (i) the purchase price paid or payable by the retailer for that imported crockery;
 - (ii) sales tax paid or payable thereon;
 - (iii) 35 per centum of the sum of (i) and (ii);
 - (b) for sales for delivery outside the metropolitan area, the price fixed by paragraph (a) of this clause for the sale of the imported crockery by retail within the metropolitan area, plus the cost actually incurred by the retailer in respect of, and properly attributable to the transport of the imported crockery from the metropolitan area to the retailer's place of business.
- (2) Where the imported crockery has been imported direct by the retailer—
 - (a) for sales for delivery within the metropolitan area, the sum of—
 - (i) importer's costs;
 - (ii) sales tax paid or payable thereon;
 - (iii) 50 per centum of the sum of (i) and (ii);
 - (b) for sales for delivery outside the metropolitan area, the price fixed by paragraph (a) of this clause for the sale of imported crockery by retail within the metropolitan area, plus the cost actually incurred in respect of, and properly attributable to the transport of the imported crockery from the metropolitan area to the retailer's place of business.

Application for Maximum Prices.

7. Any person who imports any crockery for which a maximum price is not fixed by or under the provisions of this Order shall not sell this imported crockery unless and until that person has made a written request to the Prices Decontrol Commissioner to fix the maximum price at which this imported crockery may be sold, and the Prices Decontrol Commissioner has fixed the maximum price accordingly.

Exhibition of Price Tickets.

8. Every person who sells or has for sale by retail any imported crockery, the maximum price of which is fixed by or under the *Prices Regulation Act 1948*, shall attach or display with those goods a ticket or label setting forth the selling price thereof, such ticket or label shall be in such form as to be easily legible to any person inspecting or viewing the goods, and as to be properly associated with such goods.

Fixation of Maximum Prices by Notice.

9. Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions of this Order, I declare the maximum price at which imported crockery specified in a notice given in pursuance of this paragraph, may be sold by any person to whom such notice is given to be such price as is fixed by the Prices Decontrol Commissioner, by notice in writing to that person.
