THE ROYAL ASSENT TO AN ACT SHORTLY ENTITLED THE GOVERNOR'S SALARY ACT 1949.

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c., &c.

I THE Lieutenant-Governor of the State of Victoria, in the Commonwealth of Australia, in pursuance of the provisions contained in the Australian States Constitution Act 1907 (7 Edw. VII., C.7), do by this my Proclamation signify that the Bill the title whereof is herein set forth, that is to say—

No. 5380. "An Act to amend Section Ten of the Constitution Act Amendment Act 1928"---

which was reserved for the signification of His Majesty's pleasure thereon, has been laid before His Majesty in Council and that by an Order in Council bearing date the thirtieth day of June, 1949, His Majesty has been pleased to assent to same.

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the State of Victoria this thirteenth day of July, in the year of our Lord One thousand nine hundred and fortynine, and in the thirteenth year of the reign of His Majesty King George VI.
