DETERMINATION OF A WAGES BOARD ADJUSTED PURSUANT TO SECTION 21 OF THE FACTORIES AND SHOPS ACT 1934 (No. 4275).

Clauses, other than clause 2, of the said Determination shall remain in force, provided that, to the weekly earnings of each piece-worker shall be added the sum of eleven shillings. Where less than forty hours is worked in any week by any piece-worker, a proportionate amount of such sum of eleven shillings shall be added in lieu thereof.
