One apprentice to every three or fraction of three workers engaged in any one of the following trades or occupations:—

Die sinking by hand, engraver by hand, engraver-copperplate, steel stamp cutter, badge tool maker.

Improvers.

One improver to every four workers receiving not less than 178s. per week.

Juvenile Workers, i.e., persons under 21 years of age (other than apprentices or improvers) cleaning, cutting out blanks, dipping, numbering, saw piercing, polishing, sand blasting, waxing, planing up, soldering, or press working.
