DETERMINATION OF A WAGES BOARD ADJUSTED PURSUANT TO SECTION 21 OF THE FACTORIES AND SHOPS ACT 1934 (No. 4275).

Clause 2 of the Determination published in Government Gazette No. 674 of the 29th June, 1948, shall be replaced by the following clause:—


